It appears that (Monsignor) Krunoslav Stefan DRAGANOVIC, who was annoyed by the outcome of the PUCAR case (it will be recalled that he was repatriated by the Yugoslav Legation), induced Subject, another of his proteges, to present himself to the Carabinieri station in San Lorenzo in Lucina, Rome, for the purpose of being placed in contact with the Rome CE Center.

8. PALIC has accused PUCAR of giving his name to the Yugoslav Legation. (Source Comment: This is not exact, as PALIC has always been an agent of the YIS). Subject is considered cunning, intelligent, and of good educational background.

9. Source points out that the political-information activity of Monsignor DRAGANOVIC has always been an obstacle to the Italian CE in the Yugoslav sector and he feels that the Ministry of the Interior (which protects DRAGANOVIC) should warn him not to carry out political activity, especially in the information field.
