1. Early in August 1954, Dobroslav JEVĐEVIĆ reported a visit, without any warning, from the following two Hungarian political exiles, who had arrived from Austria:
  - a. Ex-General Arpad HAMRÍ (address: Gatterbauer 104, Post Brizzen im Tale, Tyrol, Austria);
  - b. Bela FALEK (Address: Alter Kapuzinerweg 29, Innsbruck);
2. They informed JEVĐEVIĆ that they had come to Italy for the purpose of choosing a number of collaborators for a "Fascist International" which is soon to be constituted with headquarters at Munich, indicating that JEVĐEVIĆ's address and references in his regard had been given them by the ex-General COSTA (of the MSI), with whom JEVĐEVIĆ is in contact. The two Hungarians confided that they would also make contact with the Metaciz priest, Prof. Krinoslav DRAGANOVIC, and with neo-Fascist leaders of other European countries who are resident in Italy, finally going to see Bishop Cardinal TISSEYANT who is allegedly favorable toward their anti-Semantic activity.
3. During the talk which took place, HAMRÍ did not, however, give his immediate approval because the Hungarian demanded the hope of incorporating the Vojvodina (i) within the Hungarian frontiers and because Hungarian nazi-fascist killed many thousands of Serbs in the Vojvodina during the last war.
4. A few days ago, JEVĐEVIĆ received a letter from Bela FALEK in which FALEK urged JEVĐEVIĆ to adhere to the "Fascist International." As a result of agreements reached with FALEK, JEVĐEVIĆ will ask FALEK for the statute of the organization and for other details regarding it.
5. It is pointed out that the Hungarian group (headed by General HAMRÍ) publishes a newspaper in Salzburg entitled "Le Sel."
