Name Trace Reply - Monsignore DRAGANOVIC

Reference: EGQA-23811, 29 October 1956

1. Frankfurt files contain the following possible traces on one Krunoslav DRAGANOVIC who may be identical with subject mentioned in reference.

- A. CIC Report of 2 July 1952 on one Jacob MEIER aka Dr. Peter FRUET reveals that one Krunoslav DRAGANOVIC to be involved with an illegal group which aids former Utasha (Croatian Fascist Organization) personnel to escape to South America.
- B. EGMA-655, 6 Dec 54: A Prof. Krunoslava DRAGANOVIC is mentioned as being a Ustasha priest (DOB unknown) with whom two Hungarians will make contact in regard to the Project for the Constitution in Austria of a So-called "Fascist International."
- C. In addition, please refer to EGMA-17696, 1 Nov 55 and EGMA-17376, 11 Oct 55.

2. Frankfurt files contain a good deal of carded information on Dr. Krunoslav DRAGANOVIC dated 1946, however, because some of these documents are not available in COB files, we are deferring action to Headquarters.
