The following is a summary of Headquarters information on Subject.

1. Subject was born in Bosnia, west central Yugoslavia; date of birth unknown. In 1941 he was Professor of ecclesiastical history in the School of Theology, University of Zagreb. During WW II he was also a delegate of the Croat Government in the Vatican and secretary to Bishop SARIC. In 1946 he became secretary of the Confraternita Croatia, Church of San Girolamo, Rome. In 1952 he was secretary of Bratovstina Relief Association, an organization which he set up.

2. Subject is known to travel extensively and in 1949 visited Buenos Aires. It is said that he was very active in helping former Nazis emigrate to Argentina, and provided many of them with false identity papers.

3. Subject is known as an anti-Communist and has initiated much propaganda against the Tito regime. He is an opportunist who has cooperated with the West when it is to his advantage to do so. It is said that even his fellow priests and compatriots have ceased to have contact with him.

One DRAGONOVICH, K, aliases: Padre, Professor and Father; born: approximately 1903 at CROATIA; previous address: Via Tomacelli 132, ROME, Italy; nationality: Italian; occupation: Catholic Priest, who did not belong to an order; was single, approximately 5'10" in height; weighed 185-195 pounds; had brown crew-cut hair and spoke Latin, German, English, Italian, Croatian and French. (UNEVALUATED and Undated). One DRAGONOVICH, Father, no further identifying data, was listed as a CIC rat-line chief in Italy. (UNEVALUATED and Undated.)
