PICKETING OF YUGOSLAV NATIONAL
DAY CELEBRATION, NOVEMBER 29, 1967,
AT SAN FRANCISCO HALL OF FLOWERS,
9th AVENUE AND LINCOLN WAY

Copies of this communication have been furnished
locally to Army, Navy, Air Force, Department of State and
Secret Service.

A source, who has furnished reliable information
in the past, advised that the San Francisco Croatian group
which picketed the Yugoslav Consulate on November 18, 1967,
seeking to call attention to the case of KRUNOSLAV DRAGANOVICH,
would have a follow-up demonstration on November 29, 1967.
This would take place at the San Francisco Hall of Flowers,
9th Avenue and Lincoln Way, at 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., at
the time when the annual reception of the Yugoslav Consulate
in celebration of the National Day was being held. The
picketers, representing the Croatian Home of San Francisco,
do not accept the statements of the Yugoslav government
press that DRAGANOVICH voluntarily returned to Yugoslavia.
Source expected about fifty pickets to appear and to demon-
strate in an orderly manner.

A second source, who has furnished reliable infor-
mation in the past, furnished similar information, and while
he supported and participated in the previous demonstration,
he was somewhat dubious of the value of the second effort.
He indicated he would probably participate, however, in
order to insure that moderation and peaceful picketing would
prevail.

According to press reports on November 16, 1967, the
Reverend KRUNOSLAV DRAGANOVIC, known as a prominent anti-Titoist,
announced that he had voluntarily returned to Yugoslavia on
September 16, 1967, and said that reports that he had been
kidnaped were absurd.
