Policy Paper

It is of vital importance for the Committee for Free Asia to determine a broad policy and program. Once these have been determined, then plans for operations of detailed projects can be considered and approved within the framework of the over-all policy.

In the determination of policy it must be realized that we are dealing with changing basic conditions, and the policy will have to be reviewed periodically and changed where necessary.

Policies of the Committee for Free Asia now include the following:

1. To prevent the spread of the Tyranny of Russian Communism to new areas and to attack Russian Communistic Tyranny in those areas where it has enslaved free people.
2. To work with and support Asians seeking to maintain or achieve individual and national freedom for themselves and others through sincere opposition to the Tyranny of Russian Communism.
3. To affirm the inherent value of the individual of any race or creed and his right to personal freedom and religious conviction, thus opposing the spiritual and ethical denials of Russian Communism.
4. To support sincere efforts by Asians to maintain free government and productive economy on their own terms, with no attempt to advocate or promote the adoption by Asians of traditional American political or economic concepts or ways of life.
5. To encourage and help Asians to work with and for Asians for their own freedom.
6. To accept to the maximum extent feasible the advice and suggestions of cooperating Asian participants in the consideration of Committee projects and determination of targets.

7. To stress at all times the positive rather than negative attack against Russian Communistic Tyranny.
8. To consider at all times the plans and activities of the United Nations and of free governments and independent private groups working toward similar ends, to avoid duplication.
9. To consider targets in terms of races and religions as well as of geographical areas.
10. To recognize that priorities of targets must shift with changes in political or military situations.
11. To attempt to reach the majority of freedom-loving Asian people through those who are their present or potential spiritual and intellectual leaders.

* * * *

Under present conditions CFA should concentrate maximum resources on projects which have prospects of valid achievements within the measurable future. Other projects should be undertaken only when they further or at least will not impede the more immediate objectives. All projects should be subjects of constant review and evaluation in the light of then existing conditions.
