MEMORANDUM FOR: Assistant Director for Policy Coordination
SUBJECT: Committee for a Free Asia

1. Attached is a paper setting forth the final agreement between the State Department, Committee for a Free Asia, and CIA on the manner in which the Committee for a Free Asia will operate.

2. You will note that in the State Department approval, which is initialed by Mr. Barrett, two mild caveats to the final plan are made. These caveats have been subsequently ironed out, and I attach as evidence a letter from myself to Mr. John Devine of Barrett's office. A Memorandum for the Record, dated 27 December, also attached, evidences CFA approval of the agreement as expressed by its Chairman of the Board.

3. It seems to me that Mr. Wisner and Mr. Dulles, who have been conducting some talks with Barrett's office on the subject of our relationship with CFA and other matters, ought to see these attachments, which will, I hope, furnish lasting evidence that everybody has seen everything and all are in happy accord.
