MEMORANDUM FOR: CHIEF, FAR EAST DIVISION

SUBJECT : Salary and Allowances: President, DTPILLAR

1. Your memorandum for ADPC dated 17 April 1951, subject as above, has been referred to me by ADPC for decision.

2. My decision is as follows:

a. I will approve the employment of the candidate as a staff employee with his current seniority in Grade GS-15 (with possibility of promotion to GS-16) plus a total maximum representation allowance of \$5,000 per annum, thus bringing his salary to the minimum authorized salary level of \$15,000 contemplated for the position.

b. In addition, it is understood that the employee would be entitled to reimbursement for such properly vouchered operational (as opposed to representation) expenses as are currently authorized by CIA regulations.

c. Further, the provision of a suitable automobile, title to be retained by the Agency, is approved.

3. The idea that the government can provide a salary on the basic criterion that the employee will be in a position to save annually \$1,000 is specifically rejected, as is the breakdown on a basis of 60% of rental and utilities, provision for full-time servant, etc.

4. All of the above is conditioned upon an understanding that it is the OPC policy to make a vigorous, immediate search for the permanent candidate for this position, and that the present employee be returned to his previous position as soon as possible. The personal assistance of DDCI, DDP and ADPC should be enlisted in finding and "twisting" the arm of a candidate of the level required to fill this position properly. Thus the present employee should not be encouraged to make permanent commitments in the way of housing, etc. in San Francisco, but should be considered as an agent on a temporary, extraordinary field mission which requires representation expenses above and beyond those normally reimbursable through the operational voucher device.
