Herewith as discussed a project proposal on the Harvard seminar. This was discussed at some length with [] during his last visit. It appears to be right down your alley.

This sub-project has the enthusiastic endorsement of the people here. Providing personnel who attend could be of tremendous potential usefulness.

It is therefore urged that that this be presented to the Executive Committee and be approved "covertly" during the week of December 17th, so that overt negotiations with Harvard may be begun as soon as possible.

We have discussed with our consultants the matter of the Fairbanks complication. Our consultants are fully aware of the problem and have agreed to insure his non-participation in this seminar in any way. You may want to rewrite the project proposal to eliminate reference to sponsors and so forth, and make any other editorial changes you feel advisable. If you have any questions concerning this, I hope you will call us.
