1. Please give us a DTPILLAR address to pass on to interested

2. It is believed to be inadvisable at this time to consider sending a DTPILLAR representative to [] without reference to [] on the grounds that it would engender sufficient [] antagonism to discourage able [] men from approaching him. Moreover, it is impossible to by-pass [] on the matter of visas.

3. It is suggested that DTPILLAR set up an [] hqs in [] staffed with one or two HTCURIOS, several KMLOTHISES, and, insofar as possible, one or more [], [], [], etc. While it is unlikely that a big-name [] could come, it could probably be arranged for a representative of a big name such as Identity (A). However, there might be difficulties in sending anyone presently in [] because of recent mobilization restrictions on travel. If this difficulty is not overcome, DTPILLAR may well be able to interest the person mentioned in Saig 249, para. 7, who is now in New Jersey.

4. In discussions with [] it was suggested that, [] return to HTCURIO were approved, [] could stop over long enough to make some contacts with some of the [] presently residing in HTCURIO. In many ways, this latter group would better serve the purpose than others.

5. A DTPILLAR [] Hqs in [] should also have a radio outlet as well as booster facilities for their HTCURIO broadcasts. The ZACACTUS stations of [] could put out ample publicity for this and also do some primitive audience-reaction work.

6. Lastly and by far the most important point, DTPILLAR should come

out with a strong, positive, fighting program which would be given maximum publicity throughout [] perhaps something like this:

- (a) We have no axe to grind.
- (b) We are not interested in promoting any one country or group.
- (c) We are not out to encourage a narrow type of nationalism such as has led to wars between states in the past.
- (d) We are not plugging socialism, capitalism, republicanism, monarchy, communism or any other organizational form of government or society.
- (e) Rather, we intend to promote, propagate and encourage the basic principles of individual freedom, the idea of individual worth, justice, respect for law, rule by government responsible to the people, civic morality, civic order, decency. We intend to oppose with all our resources exploitation of the individual by governments, groups or parties, oppression and lawless rule, dictatorship whether by monarchs, groups or parties, even where those parties claim they represent the people. In short, we seek to spread the principles which enable all peoples of all races and color to live in amicable understanding in the same world with one another, and this must be accompanied by a rooting out of everything contrary to these principles.

The program, in short, must be sufficiently broad to attract everyone whom we wish to attract, and sufficiently positive to give it purpose and direction. And it must be well flavored with a revolutionary spirit so as to capture the dominant emotion of [] Give it guts.
