Although the fiscal director of the project DTPILLAR is going to send us a memorandum setting forth his understanding of the arrangements under were made with him during our three-way telephone conversation posterday. I shall appreciate your confirmation of my understanding that we here will handle the budget problems that here erious es felle ICO withdrawn reference request. b. If DYFILLAR expenditures for FY-1955 exceed its authorized budget, ICD will select a request, probably in July, for a deficit appropriation to cover the over-expenditures in FY-1955. You have indicated that funds for such a deficit appropriation can be found and that you will support such a request. e. MTPILLAR will meet its FT-1955 centingent obligations by making ampenditures against them in FT-1956. These ampenditures will be charged against the FT-1956 budget, even though they were not provided for in the FT-1956 budget of DTPILLAR. After Il Because 1955, IOD may request authorization for an increase in the BTPILLAR FT-1956 budget in the amount of the FT-1955 centingent obligations against which DTPILLAR will have made expanditures. Too have indicated that you will support such a request and that it will not be necessary that the funds to cover such a request be available in the ICD budget allocation. It is understood, of source, that such a request would be measured against the rate of DTPILLAR FI-1956 expenditures. In other words, if DTPILLAR in the first six months of FY-1956 spont only NOS of its authorised budget it would not be necessary for ICD to request the compensatory budget amendment described in this paragraph. However, we have discussed the fact that DTPILLAR's rate of expenditures always goes up from the beginning to the end of the fiscal year, so that, historically, it always

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spends less them one-half of its authorised budget in the first six months of fiscal year.

- d. We have also discussed the possibility that during FI-1956 DTPILLAR may find itself in a position to develop new programs not contemplated in the FI-1956 budget. Under such circumstances, ICD might wish to request additional funds to take advantage of such expertunities. You have indicated that you would prefer that may such request be lumped with any request for compensatory funds as described in the paragraph above.
- e. I have indicated that in FT-1956 DTPILLAR will not be allowed to make allocations in excess of its authorized budget, as it did in FT-1955. Therefore, we should not be faced next year with the problem of over-expenditures. (A the other hand, we will always have at the end of the fiscal year a situation of contingent obligations.
- 2. In order that the record be clear, would you please sign and return a copy of this memorandom if the above recital of the arrangements is correct? If it is not, I would appreciate a memorandom of correction.
