SUBJECT: OTPILIAR - Cover - Fund-Raising

- 1. Reference is made to previous correspondence and conversations between a number of people concerning the need for improving the cover of DTPILLAR and particularly with respect to its source of funds.
- 2. Consideration had been given to setting up a Fund for Asia, Inc. to be a non-profit, charitable foundation which would raise public funds for DTPILIAR. (See attached project outline for C).) Further discussion, however, has resulted in a decision to establish a Finance Committee of DTPILIAR rather than setting up a separate organization to handle fund-raising.
- 3. It is therefore proposed to set up within MTFILLAR a Finance committee who would undertake a fund-raising effort in behalf of MTFILLAR. James Michaner has agreed to be Chairman of such Finance Committee and consideration is being given to including some of the following in addition to a few of the present DTFILLAR committee members.

h. ETPILIAR will contract with harold h. Oram, Inc. to actually carry on details of the fund-raising. Oram estimates that he can raise about \$200,000 but, of course, is in no position to guarantee this. No other additional personnel on the part of STPILIAR are required. Note the New York and San Francisco offices of STPILIAR will be used to receipt for funds and carry-on various other details of this work.

5. Budgeted costs of this effort are:

\$3.000 a month fee to Harold L. Oram. Oram will assign two people in addition to making available other assets of his office such as contacts, lists of possible denors, and his own professional experience.

\$1.000 a month for office expenses to include postage, telephone. telegraph, office supplies, etc.

\$3,000 a menth actual fund-raising operating expenses to include transportation, organizing dinners, receptions and so forth, required to actually carry on a fund-raising operation.

- 6. Oram and DIPILLAR will work out a mutually acceptable operating program which will insure that no publicity is issued until it is cleared with DTFILLAR so that it will be consistent with DTFILLAR's operating philosophy and operating program. DTPILLAR and Oram will enter into a memorandum of agreement which will be forwarded to sponsor for approval, covering all of the above points.
- 7. It is proposed to utilise funds presently approved for DAVILLAR by the PRC. It is expected that the fund-raising will be more than selfliquidating and result in a substantial amount of public funds as noted above. DTFILLAR will reimburse itself from such public funds for actual expenses incurred for the fund-raising. The remainder of such public funds will be retained by DTPILLAR and expended for programs approved by IO Division. No additional funds in addition to the 1954 funds approved for DTPILLAR will therefore be required.
- 8. It is proposed to obtain operational clearances on the members of the Finance Committee on whom we do not now have clearances and to obtain operating clearances on reference employees of Harold L. Oram, Inc.
- 9. It is therefore requested of PAPS/DDA that the necessary adjustments

in the DTPILLAR Administrative	Plan be made to include the above.
