SUBJECT : Amendment No. 1 of Second Revised
Administrative Plan, Covert Action
Staff Proprietary Project DTPILLAR

I. Objective and Instrumentality

1. The objective of DTPILLAR is to promote the development of Asian nations along democratic anti-Communist lines by providing the organizational instruments, the knowledge, and resources through which required leadership and influence may develop. Its overt mission, as stated in its California articles of incorporation, and its covert mission are included in the Administrative Plan, paragraphs 30 and 31.

II. Background

2. In April 1951, the Agency initiated Project DTPILLAR to aid in the creation of private action institutions and groups in Asia which would provide expanding opportunities for Asians and thus counteract the appeal of communism. DTPILLAR has won widespread recognition and acceptance in Asia and is now conducting programs through resident representatives in every major Asian nation from Japan through Afghanistan, except Burma and Indonesia.

III. Need for the Amendment

3. The present paragraph 13 contains adequate authority for DTPILLAR, subject to Agency controls, to treat bona fide contributions as supplements to its budget. It reads as follows:

"13. Bona fide contributions offered to DTPILLAR may be accepted by that organization as supplements to its budget with the approval of CA Staff. If such contribution is designated for a purpose which coincides with a specific activity programmed by DTPILLAR, then such contribution shall be offset against the budgeted

allotment for that activity. However, such designated contributions may be used to supplement the DEPIIIAR budget with the concurrence of the Comptroller. CA Staff shall determine the budgetary status of such contributions. Identification of, and subsequent accounting for these funds shall be made by DEPIIIAR in its regular financial statements."

The purpose of the Amendment to paragraph 13 is to establish a procedure with respect to bona fide contributions received by DEPIIIAR. Without this procedural refinement, unnecessary and burdensome procedures would be placed on DEPIIIAR and CA Staff.

IV. Approvals

4. Project DEPIIIAR has been appropriately renewed for each fiscal year. The project was approved for for FY 1960, for FY 1961, for FY 1962, for FY 1963, and for FY 1964.

V. Recommendation

5. The attached Amendment No. 1 to DEPIIIAR Administrative Plan, approved 6 September 1963, has been concurred in by all interested Staffs and Divisions and is recommended for your approval.

DEPILLAR

Paragraph 13 of Section IX of the Second Revised Administrative Plan (approved 6 September 1963) for Project DEPILLAR is amended to read as follows:

13.

a. Bona fide contributions offered to DEPILLAR which are not designated for a purpose which coincides with a specific activity programmed by DEPILLAR may be accepted by DEPILLAR as supplements to its budget.

b. Bona fide contributions offered to DEPILLAR which are designated for a purpose which coincides with a specific activity programmed by DEPILLAR may be accepted by DEPILLAR as supplements to its budget only with approval of the CA Staff and concurrence of the Chief, Budget Division. In the absence of such approval and concurrence, such contributions shall be offset against the budgeted allotments for the specific activities during the project fiscal year.

c. The amounts of all contributions which are treated by DEPILLAR as supplements to its budget, in accordance with provisions of subparagraphs a. and b. above, will be held by DEPILLAR in a separate account and any accumulated balances may be carried over from fiscal year to fiscal year. DEPILLAR will include in its regular financial statements a full accounting for the separate account. Such accounting will be descriptive of contributions with respect to source and whether designated or undesignated, and with respect to purposes for which expenditures were made.

d. Funds in the separate account may be expended by DEFILIAR only for purposes within the scope of the annual DEFILIAR program as approved by the Agency, or for such other purposes as may be approved or directed by the Agency (CA Staff, DDP/PG, and the Budget Division).
