MEMORANDUM FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE:

INSER, Bruno Oskar (Latvian)

Interrogation of Subject regarding activities of an Anti-Soviet espionage net.

On or about 9 July 1945, Bubject was sent to CIC, ULM by a Lt. MARONI, an American officer stationed at SINGEN (near CONSTANC), after Subject had volunterred information about an antisoviet group working for the Germans during the past several years.

> Subject born 1915 at SAMARA, Russia, Married in RIGA in 1936 to Anna Jegermanis, who is presently living at PLENSBURG on the Danish-German Border.

1941

1915-1920 - In Russia. 1920 - Lart Russia with Pather, a Latheren Minister in a late immigration wave.

Lived in RIGA 1920-1941 -

High school and textile college education. Left RIGA shortly before the Russian occu-

pation. Went to Germany where he spent nine months at OELS, Silesia.

1942-1945 - BERLIN. Employed at the KUNSTSBIDEN A.G. until March 1945. Factory bombed out. Sublest moved to RADOLYSZELL, Lake Constans.

Subject speaks German, Latvian, Polish and Russian; is well educated, intelligent, and self-assured.

After interrogation it was clearly determined that all information INSER could give would be second hand and repetition of that which could be obtained from the following persons:

DULKEIT. Brunos

a Latvian working for the RSHA Abt.

VI Edst for a number of years. Presumed to be at WEZEN, near HANOVER.

Worked under Dr. GRAFET and HENGEL-HAUPT.

SESKIS, Alma

SUSPECTER RIS

Wife of the Former Latvian Ambassador to Moscow and head of the Latvian Intelligence Service in Russia. Presumed to be either in @ NSTANZ or in FULDA.

LANIN, Arthur von (Cover name Arthur LANGE). Presently at LEIBACH, Croatia,

4. VIHER, Eugene: Former Stage actor from MOSCOW. Believed to be in HERLIN.

Subject emphasized the necessity of his personal contact with the abeve mentioned people in order to obtain their eventual cooperation with the Americans. He believes that the American Intelligence Services would be willing to eventook the activities and services rendered to Germany by the above four persons, if those same individuals would give full information concerning their work against Soviet Russia for the last decade.

Subject, an anti-communist, made the acquaintance of these individuals many years ago in RIGA where he was asked to join the aspicpage group working against the Soviets... Subject pointed out to these Agents that he never offered his services to the German counter intelligence or to the above mentioned persons after he entered Germany in 1961.

These agents feel that Subject, himself, does not have information sufficient to warrant further interrogation and recommend that INSER be allowed to return to his home in HUDLESZELL where he will be available for any further uses.
