The following information received from a collaborator with a new group new under test originates from his converse tion with former SD officer Emilipopelitzer, GRAZ, who has also worked for French intelligence allegedly until a year ago,

(see report P/01738, dated July 6, 1950, Subject: Emil DUPLITZER).

- 2. On July 21 or 22, 1951, three French intelligence offic in civilian dress took quarters at GRAZ 'Erzherzog Johann' Hotel, where they had a number of conferences. The group was allegedly headed by 1st Lt.(fnu) GRENOUILLE.
- 3. The French allegedly try to establish intelligence connections with CSR at any risk and even by spending considerable sums, unusual with French IS. A number of Frenc agents in Burgenland and Styria have been ordered to open intelligence channels from the Lower Austrian border region into Ozechoslovakia.
- 4. GRAZ chief agent of this group is a certain Wolfgang BERLITZKY, who during World War II had been employed with German Abwehr at PARIS, but lateron joined maquis.
 - 5. FSS tries to watch these activities; especially BERLIT2 is shadowed.
