Emil DUPLITZER (true Name) appears in a lengthy Primer (Germany) entry.. He was born on 12 April 1917 in Constantinople, Turkey, of German or Austrian parents. He is now an Austrian citizen and lives at Graz, Koerblergasse 49. His childhood was spent in Turkey. From November 1938 to April 1940 he was a member of an SS Pioneer Battalion. On the latter date he was assigned to Amt VI of the RSHA. From June 1940 to April 1945 he worked for Amt VI in Constantinople, his intelligence assignment being concerned with the Near East. For cover purposes he was assigned to the German General Consulate in Constantinople. His last rank was that of SS Obersturmfuehrer. After the war he was taken prisoner by the English: the Austrian government later sentenced him to twenty two months of imprisonment because of his SD membership. He is presently business manager of the business firm FREUND und WIENER, Import-Export-Transit, Graz, Leechgasse 28, as well as general salesman or representative of the firm SANA, confectioners, Vienna.
