Josef ebretabergur, the leader of the Lemogratic Union.

Although Pobretsberger and sementhou meet very frequantly, they are very careful about the security of their meetings. To Cource's knowledge, the meetings always take place either at lebretsberger's Vienne apartment, which is located in Vienne I (International), Singerstrasse 27, or in tementhow's automobile, a black BMY sedam. Neetings are arranged by telephone in the following manner: Debretaborger calls sementhes at the number U-41525 and remests a meeting for a certain hour in frost of a specified street address. The meetings always take place two hours after the time specified in the telephone convergation, and the two men meet in front of the building which is fifty members higher than the address openified.

Although tementhor gives Debretaberger instructions concerning the activities of the U, the money to support both Debretaberger and his organisation is not passed directly from the Joviets to Debretaberger. The money is maked through the L-Os and is given to Ruth Yischer who delivers it to her close friend, Enria Lohestaberger, wife of Josef Lobretaberger. Each mouth Debretaberger receives from 100,000 to 110,000 Schillings. Out of this sum he is allowed 20,600 Schillings for his own expenses and the rest is used to support the IU. In addition, on certain occasions Debretaberger has received larger amounts to be used for specified projects. For example, in 1969, Debretaberger received 1.5 million Schillings to be used as a compaign fund in the parliamontary elections which took place at that time.

lobretuberger's present deputy, inclover Eichard Volf, Vienna XIII (British), Nelchartgasse 23, plays a double role within the DU. In addition to cerving as lobretaberger's deputy, he also has his own contacts directly with the loviete and reports monthly to a loviet in Vienna I, Eastgasse, concerning

This ordered in tectober 1952 when solf was instructed by his 'oviet control agent to arrange a mass meeting of the We and to sway the sumbership so that Nobretzberger would be thrown out of the party. Wolf, who would like to run the party himself and who looks down on DobruteDerger as his intellectual inferior, completed the arrangements and was firmly convinced that he had rigged the voting in such a sunner that lobretsberger would be excluded from the W. Three days before the mass meeting was to take place, wolf was told by the covicts that he was not to hold the meeting and he was not to touch lobrateberger. Furthermore, wolf was ordered to contact the people who were helping him and to undo all the harm he had done to Dobretaberger's reputation. Debretcherger heard of Wolf's machinations and since that time there has been a great seal of personal animosity between the two man; however, both men continue to play an active part in the IU on the orders of their covict superiors. Source was not able to identify bolf's poviet control agent, but he did state that Wolf is frequently picked up in a leviet medan bearing license number 2-33864.

Volf is not the only man whose primary job is to watch Dobretsburger. Since the Eroe also has an interest in Dobretsburger's activities, they have placed their own wan, Richard Zeltner, in the EU as General Secretary. He also reports on Dobretsburger's activities but forwards his reports to sensons in the control committee of the Communist Party.
