UN/FOB file traces on persons mentioned in the reference are the following:

a. Hilda DUPLITZA: One Emil DUPLITZA, born 12 April 1917 in Constantinople, is a former ZIPPERite who was dropped in November 1951 because he had ties to the French about which he had not told ZIPPER and because he refused to take over an operation of ZIPPER's which he did not like. He married Gertrud STIER in 1940, according to MCMW-10069. Emil is the son of Johann DUPLITZA, an Austrian merchant, and Anna nee WIERKAWSKA. In view of the statement in the reference that Hilda is of Austrian-French ethnic origin we suggest that she is very probably Emil's sister. We would appreciate a reply confirming or refuting this suggestion.

b. Garif SULTAN: According to MSLA-12929 (to EE COM) one Garif SULTAN was a member of the Central Committee of ABN (Antibolschevistischer Block der Nationen).
