with Cuban Diplomatic Courtesy Visa 122. Inquiry was rade of the US Immigration Department for information conserming the travel of these individuals. US Immigration advised that Fram Helmat LEITHER and Ingeborg LAITHER new SEIDL, arrived in Sey West from Havana on 12 February 1949. Among other information, their diplomatic status as Austrians and their Austrian passports were confirmed, and a US address was given as the Austrian Consulate, 683 Fifth Avenue, New York City.

- (5) A report dated 28 June 1949 states that information had been received from EGA that LeITHER, Frame is in the United States visiting various plants in the metals industry, together with Dr. DUBS and two unidentified persons. They allegedly visited 38 plants. During a visit at an unidentified plant near Fittsburgh recently they displayed more interest in naugeness than any other metal. This group is not appeared by EGA nor were we advised that they were coning to the United States. It is our understanding that LEITHER, during the Garman compation of Austria, held a position comparable to the Chairman of the Munitions Board in the US and that he is considered by some to be pro-Maxi.
- (6) A report dated 6 July 1950, attributed to Smil DUPLITZER, former Commissioner of the SD in Istanbul, states that Rechtemmelt Dr. LEXTMER of Vienna, to whom he (DUPLITZER) originally entrusted the care of his legal interests, had been MUZISCH's legal representative for a very long time. In view of this fast, DUPLITZER had broken off his relationship with LEXTMER. LEXIMER is said to have played a leading role in bringing about the conference between Bundeskumsler FIGL and Communist Nationalrut FISCHER which is known to have occurred. Probably not identical with Subject.
- (7) A report dated 23 February 1951 pertaining to an investigation of BUKOVSKI and TRUBEL, Vienna I (a recently founded Viennesse trading firm engaged in Best-West trade) states: Otto/BUKOVSKI is also a partner of the firm Frita BOUNER, one of a number of cover firms which was founded by em-Himistor KRAULHE during his temms of effice to front for his simultaneous commercial transactions. Another partner of BUKOVSKI in the ROCKER firm is Pr. LEITEER, a left-wing ex-Maxi who is reported to have been the godfather of the representations between Ernal VISCHER and Prof. Heimrich DOSRETSBERGER.
- (8) A report dated 3 October 1952 lists Frans LEITHER as a masher of the executive committee of the Communist Party Landesleitung in Lower Austria. Frobably not identical to Subject.
- (9) Dr. Frans LEXINGR referred to in RAVA-3860, dated 20 August 1953.

(10) Dr. Frans LEITRER listed in SAVA-4229, dated 21 September 1953.

(11) A report dated 8 Hovember 1946 states that Dr. IF ITHER who is currently in the PS as a representative of the Austrian Institute for the Promotion of International Trade is going to Mosocw after his return to Vienna, which is expected to be within two weeks. We understand that after the Mosocw trip he is scheduled to go to the various Balkan countries. While he was here in the States, the interested groups in the State Department held extended discussions with him and the thought occurred to our minds that you might debrief him after his trip to become, either directly or through LIMERICK.

We did not approach him ourselves for obvious reasons and, incidentally, his record is not entirely spotless as it is said that he was a nester of a fast economic mission to Rely during the war. It is also stated that he is currently thoroughly said on the value of the dollar and is attempting to get some wort of position with a part of the UN Organization.
