1. Professor Ferdinand DURČANSKY

DURČANSKY is presently residing in Munich, Germany. During the Slovak State set-up with the support of the Hitler German Government he served as Transport Minister and then as Foreign Minister. After World War II he went to Argentina where many Nazi collaborators fled after the war. He returned to West Germany about 1950. Shortly after RFE began broadcasting he put out a pamphlet entitled "Die Macken Weg" ("The Macken Army") which criticized RFE and its employees most violently. He is fanatic in his desires for an independent Slovak State. He receives support from Konrad Adenauer and German officials. He is under suspicion of being an informant for German Intelligence.
