SUBJECT : "DONK TOLLOING".

1. According to our previous oral confirmation our suggestion, that DONK TOLLOING might be identical with Dirk van DONK (16-4-1908 Leiderdorp) (See our CAH/51/385) appeared to be wrong.
2. DONK TOLLOING is indeed identical with Pierre Marie Ernest SIERENS (27-12-1918 St. Josse ten Noode near Brussels).
3. SIERENS collaborated with the Germans during the war, on account of which the Court-Martial of Tongeren (Belgium) sentenced him to death in his absence in 1946, as he was a fugitive.
4. With reference to the I.I.S interim Interrogation Report, which please find herewith attached, we may point out, that this report only contains the statements made by SIERENS himself, and should be regarded as a very smart cover-story, 99 per cent. of its contents being true facts, and one per cent. lies that are very hard to verify.

For a long time SIERENS was detained and interrogated by the English, who at the time considered him reliable.

There are various tales circulating about SIERENS' further career, the long and short of them being, that he lived and worked under different names in various countries. It is possible, that in due course some further information about this matter will come to hand.

5. Some time ago we learnt, that SIERENS was understood to have relations with WIELEMING during the latter's stay in Belgium. Later it appeared, that he had gone with WIELEMING to Tangier, under the name of DONK, but that he soon returned from that town to Belgium. (See our CAH/51/385)

Subject: DONK TOELOENGS (Dirk van DONK).

On good grounds it is to be assumed, that DONK TOELOENGS (?) is identical to Dirk van DONK (born 15-1-1908 at Lekkerkerk), of Dutch nationality, of 1926, Wijnschermenplein, Rotterdam. On April 2, 1931 he married at Lekkerkerk Leentje van Es (born 2-2-1908 at Krimpen a/d Lek).

The person in question's police-career began on April 1, 1928, when he was made tide-waiter of Lobith. In the course of years he was successively constable at Gouda and rural constable of the Municipality of Stad on the Haringvliet, and of Nieuwerkerk on the IJssel.

On November 1, 1941, he was made Government detective at Boekelo -Duo and Nimeguen. On March 1, 1943 he became sub-inspector with the Government criminal Investigation Department in The Hague. On account of his membership to the Right Front and the National Socialist Movement (N.S.B.) and his conduct during the occupation he was arrested on June 5, 1945 at Leiderdorp, and detained by the Political Investigation Department (P.I.A.). On December 2, 1946 he was discharged under the Probation of Offenders Act.

Meanwhile he had been discharged from the Police Service on January 31, 1946 under the Police Purge Order. Shortly after his second arrest in May 1947 he entered the employ of the "Nederlandse Machine Glasfabriek N.V." of Schiedam as head of staff. A little later he was dismissed in consequence of the liquidation of the concern.

He then setup a private intelligence service for the interior, which principally engaged in collecting information of a political nature, also concerning Indonesia. This intelligence service has, however, ceased to exist.

The person in question is further known to be one of those who accompanied Captain WESTPHALING from Brussels to Tangier in the chartered plane O/AMPT of the "Morton Air Service".

This plane arrived at Tangier February 1 lat; on February 3 van DONK returned by the same plane from Tangier.
