1. Direct investigations by HH 1.
2. Louis EDER, a former VdU functionary, suspected to work for Communist intelligence and known for his anti-American speeches at VdU meetings in Mühlviertel area, had withdrawn from politics some time ago and worked as traveling salesman for LINZ candy firm 'Zuckerhuber'.
3. Presently he considers the foundation of a VdU youth periodical 'Wir Furchtlosen', a project agreed to by VdU Bundesvorstand. Ostensibly EDER has changed his mind regarding the United States; the first issue of his new periodical will contain an article by Dr. Robert LEY, allegedly written during LEY's imprisonment at NUREMBERG and pleading for a German-US collaboration against the Soviets.
4. The paper will be financed partly by government subvention given to VdU youth organization (as usually paid to all party youth organizations), partly by advertising orders which have already been fixed. Thus a sum of 40,000 AS is being expected sufficient to guarantee the costs of a quarterly.
