On 27 April 1954, the following information was obtained from Informant 6030:

Recently Alois EGER, born 17 February 1911, Upper Austria, St. Florian, was visited in Linz, Upper Austria, by a Doctor Otto Schott, from Ulm, Germany. Schott allegedly attempted to recruit EGER for intelligence activities for the German "Gesellschaft fuer neue Staatespolitik" (Society for new States Policies). EGER refused Schott's offer.

SUBJECT is recently engaged as the sales representative for cash registers which are manufactured in Germany and exported to Austria. Also engaged with EGER in the selling of cash registers is Karl Kovarik. Kovarik is friendly with a former SS (Schutzstaffel - White Guard) Strubmannfuhrer (Major) (fnu) Christoph of Linz.

On 12 May 1954, the name files of the Regional Registry, 430th CIC Detachment, Region "B", and 174th Army, were examined regarding personalities mentioned in this report, and the following information was revealed:

Alois EGER: Agent Report 17/6404, HC-5331, dated 17 September 1952, and 21 January 1954, mention EGER as being a former SS officer, interned in Camp Marcus Orr, a member of the VAO (Vereinigung der Unabhangigen - League of Independents), a suspected member of the KPdO (Kommunistische Partei Oesterreichs - Communist Party of Austria), of having made anti-American speeches in the Kuhlviertel section of Upper Austria, and of being an intelligence opportunist.

Dr. Otto Schott: Agent Report, dated 15 May 1950, evaluated B-3, Subject: "Institute fuer Gegenwartforschung," states that a Dr. Otto Schott, born 1 August 1916, presently residing at Ringhoferstrasse 4, Linz, is a close friend and associate of EGER's.

Karl Kovarik: SIC, date 17 December 1950, evaluated C-1, Subject: "The National Liga," mentions an Ing. Karl Kovarik, as a personality in contact with Slovik, and a former HJ (Hitler Jugend - Hitler Youth) leader in Vienna, Austria, born 23 April 1907.
