CHIEF OF THE ARMED FORCES GENERAL STAFF. OCHOA HAS RECENTLY VISITED OFFICERS AT THE ILOPANGO AIR FORCE BASE ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS FOR THIS PURPOSE. COL. MAXIMILIANO ((LEIVA)), COMMANDER OF THE 4TH INFANTRY BRIGADE, HAS BEEN ASSISTING OCHOA IN PROMOTING A COUP AMONG THE OFFICERS CORPS. GENERAL GARCIA, WHO IS WELL AWARE OF OCHOA'S ACTIVITIES, IS ADAMANT THAT OCHOA WILL DEPART FOR HIS ASSIGNMENT TO THE INTER-AMERICAN DEFENSE COLLEGE IN WASHINGTON, D.C. NO LATER THAN 7 FEBRUARY 1983.

2. ACCORDING TO FLORES LIMA ON 3 FEBRUARY 1983, THERE IS NOT YET SUFFICIENT SUPPORT IN THE MILITARY FOR A COUP BUT THE SITUATION IS DELICATE AS GENERAL GARCIA, WHOSE RESIGNATION IS INCREASINGLY SOUGHT IN THE OFFICER CORPS, HAS PROVIDED NO ASSURANCES OF RESIGNING AND, IN FACT, WANTS TO REMAIN IN OFFICE. IN FLORES LIMA'S VIEW, IF GARCIA DOES NOT RESIGN OR MAKE A COMMITMENT TO DO SO IN THE NEAR FUTURE, ELEMENTS OF THE ARMED FORCES, SUPPORTED BY THE NATIONALIST REPUBLICAN ALLIANCE (ARENA) PARTY, COULD BE PROMOTED TO ATTEMPT A COUP.

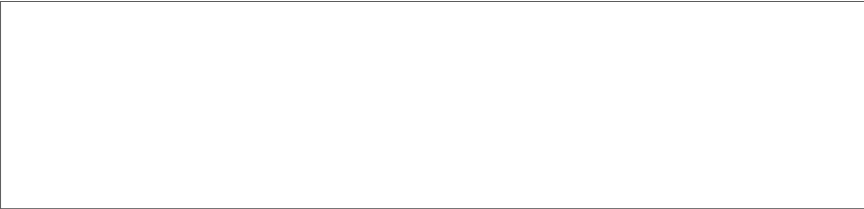
3. ONE INDICATION TO FLORES LIMA OF GARCIA'S INTENTIONS TO REMAIN IN OFFICE IS THE VERY HEAVY PRESSURE HE IS EXERTING ON FLORES LIMA TO ACCEPT THE CURRENTLY VACANT POSITION OF SUB-SECRETARY OF DEFENSE. FLORES LIMA SEES THIS AS PART OF A PLAN BY GARCIA TO STRENGTHEN HIS POSITION AND IMPROVE HIS CHANCES TO REMAIN IN OFFICE. FLORES LIMA SAID THAT GARCIA HAS GIVEN HIM UNTIL 4 FEBRUARY TO ACCEPT THE SUB-SECRETARY POSITION OR BE ASSIGNED ABROAD AS A MILITARY ATTACHE OR RESIGN. GARCIA'S CANDIDATE TO REPLACE FLORES LIMA IS COL. MARIO ADALBERTO ((REYES)) MENA, COMMANDER OF THE 2ND INFANTRY BRIGADE, WHOM FLORES LIMA DESCRIBED AS POLITICALLY NEUTRAL AND A "GOOD SOLDIER". PRIOR TO COMMITTING HIMSELF, FLORES LIMA WILL MEET WITH GARCIA ON 4 FEBRUARY IN AN ATTEMPT TO DETERMINE GARCIA'S INTENTIONS AND STRATEGY.
