Brief Case History : Joined Nazi party and Allgemeine SS in 1933. Posted to Auslands Devisen Referat (Foreign and Currency Dept.) of the SS Fuehrungsabruptant (FA). In 42 was transferred to the Waffen SS with rank of Obersturmfuehrer. Worked for FIA throughout the war and maintain that his contacts with L. Intelligence were purely incidental. Arrested by Swiss authorities in Jun 45 but nothing could be proved against him and was released in Oct 45. Probably used his SS connections chiefly in order to feather his own nest. See CSDIC/CIE/SD 90.

Functions at AMT VI are shared by SCHNEIDER (QV) and a third, unknown person.

Subject is described as an agent who acts as a transmitter and receiver of secret information between AMT VI and other foreign agencies in Switzerland. He acts as liaison between AMT VI and other foreign agencies in Switzerland. One of Subject's contacts in Switzerland is Dr. FREDERICK H. BROWN (QV-3424), but no details are provided.
