Subject: Hans EGGEN's Friends in Milan.

1. Before final arrangements were made for EGGEN's departure his intermediary came to us with the following names of persons in Milan who were friends of EGGEN and who wanted to keep in touch with him. They are:

M. and Mme. SCHENK  
Cotonificio Italianna (?)  
Milan

2. We gathered that these people enjoy rather good relations with both the Allies and the Italians. EGGEN wanted the couple to be informed of his arrival, being under the impression that they could visit him.

3. We might point out that EGGEN had a slightly optimistic picture of his immediate future, considering himself rather in the light of a simple traveller, rather than as a dangerous and undesirable intelligence agent.
