ADOLF EICHMANN
INTERNAL SECURITY - ISRAEL

On August 4, 1960, an informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that a representative of the International Press Service reported the German Embassy had called in a few newspapers on August 4, 1960, for the benefit of meeting a Mr. Drvia Schueler, the Director of the Central Headquarters of Judicial Authority for Clarification of Nazi crimes.

The press representative noted that Schueler was working on such projects here in the United States and it was revealed at the press conference that Schueler had found, while working in the War Records Center, the complete file relating to Eichmann's office.

According to recent newspaper accounts, Adolf Eichmann is presently in custody in Israel where he is being charged with the crime of killing 6,000,000 Jews during the Hitler regime in Germany.

Abraham Tadmor, the Second Secretary at the Israeli Embassy, Washington, D.C., was not acquainted with the records concerning Eichmann. Schueler, when asked if he would advise the government of Israel about his findings, said that he was just an individual, but his government was in close contact with the Israelis. Tadmor has confirmed that the German government has been very cooperative in the Eichmann case.

The press representative also noted that Schueler had mentioned an organization in Israel, the Yad Vashem, which collects all available information on Nazi criminals still at large, as having a part in the locating of Eichmann.

Indoor was of the opinion that this organization had a great deal to do with Richmann's capture. The director of Yad Vashem is one Mr. Kubovl (Phonetic), the former Israeli Ambassador to Argentina. Also, Fania Friedman, who was recently in the United States and who was said to be responsible for Richmann's location, was also very active in the organization which is operated by the Jewish Agency (formerly the Jewish Agency for Palestine).

The position of Indoor at the Israeli Embassy, Washington, D.C., was obtained from the June, 1960 issue of the "Diplomatic List" published by the United States Department of State.
