Dr. ENNER (identified in report as identical with EYLITZ, Herbert) Not impressive. A playboy type. Also uses the name MUELLER. Height 5'7" tall, medium build but with broad shoulders, dark or sunburnt complexion, dark hair and eyes, low forehead, ears very protruding, oval face. Source says he was in Tunisia in 1942 along with other Berlin SD officers Source knew. Was in Athens sometime between April and late July 1944 when Source was there awaiting to be dispatched to Syria. Told source through indiscreet talk in Athens about a planned German operation in Iraq."</p>
