A What is his name ?

F His name is Dr. Emil AUGSBURG, like the city near Munich.

A-U-G-S-B-U-R-G. And he has two other names: the one is

Dr. ALBERTI and the other one Dr. ALTHAUS. He came originally

from the so-called Hochschule fuer Politik - means sort of a university

for politics in Berlin. And he promoted - there he got his degree as a

doctor, being a doctor of political science. In the Third Reich he was

with SS of course. He was an SS Sturmbannfuhrer which means in the

rank of a major in the SS. He had a leading position in the so-called

Wannsee Institut. This Wannsee Institut was part of RSHA, Branch VI.

He speaks fluently Russian and Polish and Ukrainian and some other

Eastern dialects and languages. He has a lot of connections and contacts

to people from - well, emigres as well as under-cover people which were

formerly in Eastern states and Satellite states and live now in the Bundes

Republik and so on, especially to emigres from the Polish people and from

the Soviet Union. During the war I think he was at least sometimes on

special services in Russia where you never know what his real duties were.

They are covered up like most of these. I personally think he must have

had to do with the so-called Einsatzkommandos which had to do with Jews

and the elimination of Jews and so on.

B He doesn't live with his wife.

F Maybe we can continue a little on this fellow here: ALBERTI or ALTHAUS or really AUSBURG. Well I told you he has a lot of contacts with Polish people and with people from Russian origin - emigres and I don't know what else. He came into our organization in 1948, in Karlsruhe again, and in December 1953, he too came from Karlsruhe to headquarters, in the same group together with RISCHKE, with FELFE, and to the same branch. He lives separated from his wife and has a mistress with the name of DEUTSCHENDORF, first name Lydia. She was his former secretary when he was working in Karlsruhe, in the Karlsruhe organization. G.V.L. More or less one of the greater staffs of the old organization.

B He is a big man.

F White hair now.

B Long time he has white hair.

F Yes, almost all the time we know him. It's not a matter of old age but of - well he's just made that way with white hair. His contacts, especially his contacts with people from Polish and Russian origin are to say the least, or the simplest, not clear. Maybe he is honest.

A I don't know him.

F You don't know him. Have you ever heard of one of these names written

down here: the first one UMANSKI, Oleg.

A No. Maybe, but I am not sure about these names.

F These are cover names from the same fellow.

A I am not sure.

F You are not sure. This so-called Wannsee Institut was a special institute for RSFA where they collected basic material for later operations of - well, positive intelligence or destructive operations, propaganda.

A That organization is known to them of course.

F Yes, certainly must be well-known.

A But I don't have any comments on this matter.

F Well, if you don't have there is nothing to be said more about him. They belonged more or less all together. I suppose there is not much sense in telling you names.
