We have been encountering difficulty in getting ODUNIT to honor its commitment to reproduce photographs passed to us by [] To date we have got back from ODUNIT the requisite nine copies of about 600 of the photographs. It was recently discovered that the major factor in this breakdown of processing was the fact that ODUNIT staff elements have not been forwarding the photographs given them promptly to the elements actually doing the reproduction.

3. It should be pointed out that this delay puts us in a somewhat embarrassing position vis-a-vis [] Also, [] states that the completion of the finished reports consolidating the observations of all the []-sponsored observers of given installations is being held up pending receipt of the copied photographs, which are to be keyed into the text and appended to the reports. Incidentally, it has become clear that all the material we have processed to date is based on the raw "working papers" which the [] analysts are using to prepare the consolidated reports and that [] promise to give us three copies of each report referred to the finished reports only and that is why, except for duplications as noted above, we have been receiving only one copy of each report.
