1. In addition to making arrangements for economic relations between Argentina and Germany, the following two general problems affecting Latin America were discussed during the confident at conversations held by President PERCM and West German Economic Minister Arman

2. <u>Minister ENMARP</u> took a positive attitude to these concretely formulated questions presented by ESRON. 3. Oerman Anbassador Dr. Arthunds had also tried to influence S2H22D in this respect.
