4. Any communications between the CIA Inspector General's office and the NYPD regarding the Agency's collaboration with the NYPD.

Your appeal has been accepted and appropriate arrangements will be made for its consideration. You will be advised of the determinations made.

In order to afford requesters the most equitable treatment possible, we have adopted the policy of handling appeals on a first-received, first-out basis. Every reasonable effort will be made to respond as soon as possible.
