Dear Mr. Snyder:

The office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator has received your 18 April 2005 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records on **Jozef Swiatlo, who was one of the most important functionaries of the Polish Ministry of Public Security**. We have assigned your request the number above. Please use this number when corresponding so that we can identify it easily.

We conducted a search of our computerized system of previously released material and located three responsive records, totaling 10 pages. As the cost of searching for and reproducing these reports is minimal, there will be no cost to you in this instance.

With regard to any additional material, however, the CIA can neither confirm nor deny the existence or nonexistence of any CIA records responsive to your request pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). An explanation of these exemptions is enclosed.

The CIA official responsible for this determination is Scott Koch, Information and Privacy Coordinator. You may appeal this decision by addressing your appeal to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 45 days from the date of this letter. Should you choose to do this, please explain the basis of your appeal.
