Under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. subsection 552, I am requesting information or records on Charles Edward Denight Sr., Lt. Col., USAF (retired). I would like to know if Charles ever worked for, or with, the CIA, and details and specifics if available. Charles [redacted] passed away in June 1979. I am interested in this information solely because I am compiling a family history and [redacted] had a suspicion [redacted] may have been associated with the CIA, etc., in some capacity. I saw information he was considered for the OSS during or right after WWII, but at that time [redacted] was still an Australian citizen, so I don't think he was selected. I also saw some records saying he was supposed to be in Communications but was actually involved with Intelligence. [redacted] says he used to travel to hot spots a lot, Guatemala etc., in the 1950s and would say he couldn't talk about it. I know in the spring of 1962 [redacted] he was going to Laos for a year. [redacted]
