Dear Dr. Rothmiller:

This is a final response to your 22 July 2015 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for **“the following records: As listed in Studies in Intelligence, Vol. 11 No. 1 Winter 1967. MCB No. 60-1, Analysis of Factory Markings on the Last Stage of the Soviet ‘Lunik’ Space Vehicle.”** As you will recall, in our 20 August 2015 letter, we informed you that we had already begun processing a request for this information in connection with an earlier FOIA request received prior to yours. We cross-referenced your request to the earlier one in order to send you any records that were found to be releasable.

The earlier case has concluded. Our search located material which was determined to be currently and properly classified and must be withheld in its entirety on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). An explanation of exemptions is enclosed. Exemption (b)(3) pertains to information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant statutes are Section 6 of the Central Intelligence Agency Act of 1949, as amended, and Section 102A(i)(1) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended. As the CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 90 days from the date of this letter. Please include the basis of your appeal.


