We will search for only the following CIA leadership team members – Director, Deputy Director, Inspector General, and the General Counsel. However, please provide us with the domain that you would like us to search from the White House, Office of the President, and the Office of the Vice-President. We will hold your request in abeyance for 45 days from the date of this letter pending your response.
