Older brother of Qemal Farka (qv). Professional officer. Worked with Oakley Hill and Abas Kupa (qv) early days of the Italian occupation. Later with Kupa in Movement of "Legality". Escaped from Albania December 1944, with Zogist-Ballist group from Soutari. Transferred to Camp #1 Bari and March 1945 transferred to Rome.

Subject is a former Albanian army officer who is alleged to be a TITO agent. Said KRYEZIU (qv) is believed to have established ODI-USFA-Germany contact with Subject and Qasim MULETI (qv) for the purposes R-5-48-49 of establishing a "Democratic Movement of Liberation" C-3 throughout Italy for Albanian exiles. 1 Oct. 1949

Reported as Ibrahim FARKU. Former Albanian Army officer now in Italy. Rptd that Sajd KRYEZIU and DEVA had settled their differences and planned work together on DEVA's project for recruiting anti-Communist Albanians.

Reported as Ibrahim FARKU. Former Albanian artillery captain. Arrived in Istanbul from Italy, apparently to select and recruit about 20 Albanians to be infiltrated as agents into Albania from Italy. Former Zogist partisan, has turned anti-monarchist, and is now, source believes, a member of the Albanian Agrarian Party, which is headed by Sajd KRYEZIU. Friend of Avni DERALLA (qv) although a political opponent.. okd

A letter dated 26 June 1951 from Haxhi CILAGU (qv), an Albanian living in Istanbul, to Fiqri DINE (qv) in Greece, states that Subject came to Istanbul 15 days ago as a member of Sajd KRYEZIU's party, and that Subj. and his comrade Hasan KALOSHI (qv) (KRYEZIU's representative in Istanbul) started their mission by trying to attract membership to their party "in every way (with propaganda and money)."
