B. TESTS MADE WITH REGULAR TORPEDOS IN SEVEN KK BASIN AT TORPEDOVERSUCHSANSTALT, ECKERNFORDERDE BEI KIEL. RESULTS RECORDED MEANS OSCILLOGRAPH. NO LIVE OR COMBAT TESTS MADE. PERIOD TESTS SUMMER 1944 TO FEB 1945.
