This is a final response to your 3 October 2014 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, received in the office of the Information and Privacy Coordinator on 6 October 2014 for **copies of any and all pornographic, sexual or adult material including nudity of any sort (video, magazine, DVD or other) from Osama Bin** Laden compound on or about 5/2/2011 in Pakistan. In accordance with section 3.6(a) of Executive Order 13526, the CIA can neither confirm nor deny the existence or nonexistence of records responsive to your request. The fact of the existence or nonexistence of requested records is currently and properly classified and is intelligence sources and methods information that is protected from disclosure by section 6 of the CIA Act of 1949, as amended, and section 102A(i)(l) of the National Security Act of 1947, as amended, to the extent that this material exists, the CIA would be prohibited by 18 USC Section 1461 from mailing obscene matter. Therefore, your request is denied pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). I have enclosed an explanation of these exemptions for your reference and retention. As the Acting CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 45 days from the date of this letter. Please include the basis of your appeal.
