This is a final response to your 29 January 2013 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, submitted on behalf of The National Security Archive, for "All documents about the death and/or disappearance of Oscar Eduardo Barillas Barrientos, aka 'Tono' from 1983 to 1987." We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 431, as amended. Our processing included a search for records as described in our 11 February 2013 acceptance letter.

Although our searches were thorough and diligent, and it is highly unlikely that repeating those searches would change the result, you nevertheless have the legal right to appeal the finding of no records responsive to your request.
