MEMO FOR RECORD: (Cont'd)

This memo reqt approp inv; states that while Army has inv juris number of civilians involved appears to warrant ref to FBI; incl S/I 20 Dec 50 re GOODFELLOW, lists present associates, refers to S/I on D'HERNSTEIN which was fwd to FBI by Survey Sec, fwd S/I re GOODFELLOW. (b)(3)

Previous inv of GOODFELLOW revealed intimate asses with Adrian, Joseph H. and Francis H. Rosenbaum, who were involved in varying degrees with espionage for Soviet; that GOODFELLOW's secretary since about 1931, Ellen A. Dockery

that comments of [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] indicated GOODFELLOW had been involved in off-color financial deals while publisher of the Brooklyn Daily Eagle; that GOODFELLOW had revealed to firm in which Adrian Rosenbaum was interested a bid by a competitor on material for OSS; that GOODFELLOW had discussed highly classi material conc an OSS operation in the presence of an enlisted chauffeur. (b)(1)

General Belling directed act to trf GOODFELLOW fr MI, USAR and to discharge him from commission, if possible, at time of orig reqt to MDW for inv and reem.
