ATTEMPT TO DISSUADE THEM FROM INCREASING CONTACTS WITH COMMU-NIST CHINA, AMBASSADOR CH'EN REPORTED THAT HIS CONVERSATIONS WITH THESE OFFICIALS HAD RESULTED IN THE FOLLOWING ASSURANCES:

- A. BELGIAN MINISTER OF DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE
 RAYMOND SCHEYVEN, WHO HAD BEEN A LONG-TIME ADVOCATE
 FOR RECOGNITION OF PEKING, HAD AGREED TO USE HIS TWILLDENCE TOWARD ASSURING THAT BELGIUM WOULD MAKE NO DEGISION
 ON PEKING RECOGNITION UNTIL PRESIDENT NAXON VISITED
 BELGIUM.
- B. THE NEW MINISTER OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, LEBURTOR,
 HAS AGREED TO SOLICIT SUPPORT FOR THE GRO IF AND WHEN
 THE PARLIAMENT DISCUSSES THE QUESTION OF WHETHER OR NOT
 TO RECOGNIZE PEKING.
- C. NORBERT HOUGARDY, A LEADER OF THE LIBERTY AND PROGRESS PARTY, HAS AGREED TO PROPOSE TO THE BELGIAST FOREIGN MINISTER THAT THE GOVERNMENT'S INTENTION RECOGNIZE PEKING SHOULD BE DISCUSSED BY THE BELGIAN PARLIAMENT.
