10. (a) <u>Action Reported by Field:</u>								
1. <u>Guerrilla Warfare and Resistance</u>								
The GRDAGGER FM course was planned and successfully presented to six GRDAGGER potential resistance leaders at a remote and secure military training area in central Austria. A complete report on the conduct and content of the course is now available at Hqs. (GRDAGGER is an Austrian labor union with Hqs. in Vienna.)								
Three GRDAGGER numbers continue to receive W/T training in Salzburg.								
2. <u>Evacuation and Escape</u>								
Principal agents in the three segments of the E and E line continue to spot and assess potential candidates. (GRBLAMED, GRREPAIR, GRPIGLET-GIVING)								
The initial reconnaissance of an additional E and E line in eastern Austria, from Vienna east to Eisenars, has been completed. Further reconnaissance, for safehouses and other facilities is being carried out. (GRALTER, a former FI project being converted to a FM project and now doing FM work.)								
3. <u>Caching</u>								
A W/T set was cached in the greater Vienna area specifically for future use of the GRDAGGER organization. (Caching done by GRDAGGER 2).								
4. <u>Administration</u>								
A changeover in case officers handling the central and western segments of the E and E line has been accomplished without difficulty. [ ]								
(d) <u>Security Factors:</u>								
1. A prospect <sup>ive</sup> agent for the central segment of the E and E line reacted negatively to a recruitment approach by the departing case officer mentioned above. The candidate showed hesitancy, whereupon the case officer emphasized the need for security for candidate's protection as well as for others, and did not discuss the matter further. It is believed that the candidate will not disclose the matter to anyone.

2. GRREPAIR 3 was given an LCFLUTTER. No negative information was developed; however, the agent reacted unfavorably to the test. It is believed that no permanent harm was inflicted upon the case officer-agent relationship. Agent is now spotting and assessing a potential W/T asset for the central segment of the E and E line.
