1. Munich Base has ascertained that gold bars are legally obtainable on the German economy at a purchase price of DM 57.00 (U.S. \$13.57) per ten-gram bar. We propose, therefore, to purchase ten of these bars and cache them for GRIMPASTE.

2. We request that Headquarters amend the GRIMPASTE Sub-Project to include provisions for the purchase of ten gold bars for caching purposes at a total cost of DM 570.00 (U.S. \$135.70). The gold will, in effect, be cached by the agent and will pass from KUBARK control at the time of burial. Purchase of the gold will be accomplished through a Munich Base purchasing agent which should ensure operational sterility of the bars. We should like to purchase and cache this material during the late spring or summer of 1960.
