From information received we learn that 2nd/Lt. telegraphist, Papadimitriou, was executed in Athens, for spying together with A. Venizelos.

MURDERS :- During May 1943, in Pireaus street, Athens, a child aged about 12, attempted to take a loaf of bread from a german lorry stationed there. As soon as the child was seen by the german guard, the latter fired on his direction and the child fell dead.

In October 1943, a german soldier entered a bar in Athens and asked the owner to serve him a drink. The latter explained that the bar was out of bounds for all ranks, and could not serve any drinks. On his refusal, the german fired and wounded the owner very seriously. He died a few days later from his wound. The name of the victim is unknown.

On the 12/12/43, 10 Greek civilians were executed in Thebes in reprisal for the murder of Mrs. Mayer, wife of the German commanding officer of Kopais Works. The names of the victims are the following :4

On the 29/12/43, 2nd/Lt. K. Karamanolis, was executed in Athens, by organs of the German police because a wireless transmitter was found in his house.

On the 12/12/43, 10 hostages from the Maidarion concentration camp were taken and executed in Athens, in reprisal for the murder of men belonging to the security battalions.

On the 3/1/44, 30 others of the same concentration camp were executed.

On the 15/1/44, 10 more were executed in reprisal for the murder of german soldiers.

On the 8/1/44, in the Kopais area, 100 hostages were executed in reprisal for the murder of 2 german soldiers.

On the 18/4/44, 10 persons who were arrested on the previous night, in Athens, for not possessing identity cards, were executed in reprisal for the murder of men belonging to the Security battalions.

In January 1944, german soldiers fired and killed a young man aged 16 of unknown identity in Pireaus, for taring off a proclamation of the german occupation authorities posted on a wall.

ARRESTS :- From reports received in January 1944, we learn that since the S.S. German battalions undertook the security, terrorism, shootings, arrests and violations of greek civilians increased even in Athens. Old and new prisons created by the germans are packed. The existence of the detained is unbearable. Undernourishment, torture and the daily compulsory work, kill constantly hundred and hundreds of them.

In the Hadjoosta orphanage, which is transformed into a prison, 2050 persons are detained. From these, 1700 are invalids from the Greek-Italian campaign. Their situation is desperate. The rooms are so overcrowded that they are unable to stand. Many of them still have their wounds open. Lacking any hygienic attendance, they are condemned to the most tragic death. Amongst the detained are women, children, old men etc.

In our bulletin C. 13, we reported the arrest of Reizi, aged 14. Her name is EVLACHIA REIZI, and was arrested with her mother Marica Reizi, wife of the persecuted Michael Reizi.

In December 1943, in the Pangration quarter of Athens, 70 men were arrested as hostages, because a german soldier was found dead. They were sent to Maidarion concentration camp.

During the same period and for the same reason, several hostages from the Koukaki quarter, were arrested.

On the 11/1/44, Major of gendarmerie Hormovas, was arrested in Athens, for unknown reason.

In January 1944, 32 officers and civilians were arrested in Athens, on the excuse that they belonged to a National Organisation. Amongst them was Herouvimidis, Captain of gendarmerie. Also, the sub-commander of Athens security, Xipolitas, was arrested for belonging to National organisation.

Barrister Stathopoulos, who was arrested for helping the escape of jews, is amongst the 1200 detained in the Maidarion concentration camp of Athens.

Dimitri Pavlakis, Yoannis Fotinelis and George Fourmaras, all employees, are amongst these arrested by the Italians and actually detained by the Germans in the Athens prisons.

Many of the above were released after payment of an important sum to the germans. Thus, Dimitrios Argyropoulos, Capt. of gendarmerie, death sentenced by the Italians, was released by the Germans after payment of 7 million Drachmas.

IMPRISONMENTS :- On the 19/4/43, the following were arrested in Pireaus for National activity :-

Christos Ploutis, who was condemned to 15 years imprisonment, his wife Marica Ploutis, condemned to 1 year imprisonment and Miss Giaka Maritsa, to 15 years imprisonment.

ACTS OF ARSON :- The destruction caused by acts of arson in the villages and inhabited localities of Greece, has taken such an extent that it threatens the complete and entire destruction of the Country. The Germans without any reason set fire, and destroy entire areas.

According to confirmed and official reports, approx. 1 and half million victims of these acts of arson are walking round from town to town unclothed, without food and housing.

Herebelow we give a numerical list of villages per areas completely destroyed as well as a numerical list of families. In this list the number of partly destroyed villages is not included.

In November 1943, Kapsi village was burnt to the ground by German detachments in reprisal for Guerilla activity in the Karpenission town area. These German detachments plundered the town and carried the booty to Lamia.

In December 1943, Heraida was blown up in reprisal for Guerilla activity.

The villages Derminiti, Nihori, Karitsa and Kravassaras (Amphilohia) were partly destroyed due to bombing and acts of arson.

Similarly the following villages were burnt to the ground. Kyriakos, Kaparelli and Stephani.

The following villages were partly destroyed.

The inhabitants of Ano and Kato Zahlorous had the same fate.

On the 4/12/43, all men of these villages were killed by German detachments before the complete destruction of the villages. 5 men only succeeded to escape, throwing themselves in the Voraiko river.

On the 13/12/43, the Germans assembled all inhabitants of Roghoi village in the square and suddenly began the mass execution. A priest was executed while he was conducting the holy service, because he dared to protest against the executions.

Even the Monastery of Aghia Lavra has not been respected by the Germans. On the 13/12/43, they entered in the Monastery and there they found only 3 monks: Efthalios, Vassilios and Serafeim who remained as a guard of honour of their Monastery. The Germans executed these heroes, plundered the monastery and at last destroyed completely the Monastery.

During the same period Kerpini village (Kalavrita) was destroyed by German detachments in reprisal for their failure against Guerilla.

disobeyed the order not to approach Evros river up to a distance
of 500 meters.

On the 18/1/44, the German occupation authori-
ties executed without trial 5 inhabitants of Berras. The reason
of their execution was to terrorise the population. After that,
many women and children abandoned their houses and took refuge
to the mountains.

On the 24/1/44, another 5 hostages were executed
in the square of Didimotikon town for the same reason.

On the 26/1/44, 5 hostages were executed in Nea
Orestias, in reprisal for the murder of German agents by Gueril-
las. Among the executed is REGGAS, brother of the Guerilla.

In January 1944, 10 hostages were arrested in
Soufli and executed without trial in reprisal for the murder of
german soldiers.

ARRESTS :- In January 1944, George Tsatsos, Athanase Coulourtsis
and Evangelos Yakouvidis were arrested as hostages
in Dikea village.

In Souflion, 16 civilians were arrested and detained
as hostages.

In Nea Orestias, 26 civilians were arrested as hos-

In January 1944, a Greek lady teacher was arrested in Didi-motikon for National activity. The German Court Martial condemned her to 15 years imprisonment. During her trial she declared that she did everything in her power for the liberation of her Country and that she was ready to continue to do so. The condemned was sent to Salonica's prison.

C R E T E

EXECUTIONS :- In October 1943, Emmanuel Vidani and Yossef Kanakoussaki were death sentenced by Hanion German Court Martial and executed. The following were executed for collaboration and food supplying Greek Guerilla groups of the Island. 1) Matheos Boyadzis 2) Paul Petrakis, from Aghios Georgios (Lassithion) 3) Emmanuel Lambraki, from Arkalohorion (Heraklion) 4) Panadellis, driver.

MURDERS :- In September 1943, 1.000 persons from Viannou area were executed in reprisal for Guerilla activity. The following names are known :-

In September 1943, Capt. of cavalry Haralambos Raptakis, was arrested and executed without trial for collaborating with Guerillas.

On the 4/11/43, Emmanuel Kalikakis aged 60, Adam Karofilakis and Constandinos Pitnaroulis were executed by organs of the German police in the Avrakonte (Lassithion)village) because no arms were found in their houses.

On the 5/11/43, the following were executed in the Tsermi-ades village (Lassithion):- 1) George Papadakis, notary, 2) The two sons of Eleftheriou Pitharouli 3) Emmanuel Tsamandouras and another of unknown identity.

During the same day, Ioannis Koukoulakis and Xanakis were executed in Krissa village (Lassithion):

ARRESTS :- In October 1943, Emmanuel Mandzadakis was arrested in Hania for taking part in National organisations. He was death sentenced by the Hannon German Court Martial, but later this sentence was changed to life imprisonment.

During 1943, Ioannis Kalogherakis was arrested in Galara (Keraclion) village and confined in prison where he still remains, for participating in Guerilla organisations.

In October 1943, the following were arrested in Vassilika Aroghia :- 1) Ioannis Mouzourakis 2) Yossif Vranakis 3) Miron Heratsakis, because they helped and hid the crew of a British plane which made a forced landing. Their fate is unknown.

PLUNDERS :- The plundering of production and fortunes of the inhabitants of the island and especially of Lassithion prefecture has taken a more systematic form. Sheeps, vegetables, corn and tobacco production are to the Germans disposal, who seize everything without paying any indemnity. The population of the island is in a desperate situation. The invaders have officially compelled the inhabitants to hand over 55% of their production as a tax. The remaining 45% is taken from them under the form of reprisal, requisition etc.

ACTS OF ANSON :- According to latest reports, we learn that the villages, Kefalovrissi, Kalami, and Sikologos of Viannou eparchy are burnt to the ground. The inhabitants who escaped the slaughter were deported from this eparchy.

E U V O E A

ACTS OF ANSON :- During 1943, the villages Aghia Anna and Platana were partly set on fire.
On the 15/1/44, German detachments attacked diversion, plundered and burnt several houses in reprisal for Guerilla activity.

A E G E A N I S L A N D S

EXECUTIONS :- From reports received in January 1944, we learn that the Germans executed a Greek civilian of unknown identity in Scas for hiding an Italian soldier in his house.

D O D E C A N E S E

MURDERS :- In January 1944, a German soldier attempted to rape the daughter of Nicolas Stregha, in Leros. As her father resisted both of them were killed in their house.

ARRESTS :- On the 29-30/1/44, Shepherd Stamatios Hicouyannis, was arrested near Alinta village (Leros) for possessing a British gun and an empty box of ammunition.

IONIAN ISLANDS

ACTS OF ARSON :- As it is already known, during September 1943, Corfu and Cephalonia were seriously bombed by the Germans. Apart the complete destruction of Corfu and Argostoli towns, the following villages were completely destroyed:- Lixouri, Falakrata, Rapsata, Thavkata, Parsa, Dilinata, and Lakithra (Cephalonia).

I T A L I A N A T R O C I T I E S

M A I N G R E E C E

EXECUTIONS :-

On the 26/9/42, Periclis Tsingalis was death sentenced by the Italian Court Martial in Athens and executed.

Similarly on the 7/1/43, Aristidis Tsourtsoulis was executed.

ARRESTS :- During 1943, 2nd/Lt. Spanokoletis and Athanassios Hondropoulos, merchant, were arrested and tortured in Athens, for unknown reason.

After Italy's collapse, they were handed over to the Germans and were released in January 1944.

IMPRISONMENTS :- In March 1943, Constandinos Tsakalinis was arrested in Athens because he partook in the strikes of Athens and Piraeus. He was condemned by the Italian Court Martial of Athens to 12 years imprisonment. After Italy's collapse, he was delivered to the Germans and detained in the Averoff prisons.

In May 1943, George Hadzaroulas, aged 18, was arrested in Athens and condemned to 5 years imprisonment for unknown reason. He was tortured and released after Italy's collapse. (November 1943).

P E L O P O N E S E

DEPORTATIONS-EXILES:- On the 2/2/42, George Kokiopoulos was arrested in Kailokastron for hiding and food supplying British soldiers.

On the 22/5/42, he was condemned by the Italian Court Martial in Tripoli to one year imprisonment and was sent to Italy on the 23/12/42.

Together with the above the following were sent to prisons in Italy :- 1) Evang. Bordos, for hiding British soldiers 2) Theodoros Trimboukis, from Distomon (Levadia) 3) Christos Petinaris, Shephard from Levadia 4) Dimitrios Pongas Colonel, for helping the escape of British officers. 5) Mrs. Anastassopoulos, for the same reason. 6) George Vernikos, butcher 7) Kalogheropoulos, from Athens 8) Mrs. Limberopoulos 9) Sotirios Kalapias, from Messolongui.

T H E S S A L Y

ARRESTS:- In June 1943, the father and sister of Flight Lieut. Alex Papayoannou, who was persecuted for National activity, were arrested in Larissa. A few months later, the father was released. The sister was handed over to the Germans after Italy's collapse.

ACTS OF ANSON :- During 1943, Rodia village (Moussalar) near Larissa was set on fire by both Italian detachments and a Roumanian legion. During the fire the inhabitants were ill-treated. Kaladzi family was submitted to various trials. The mother was particularly ill-treated because she refused to reveal the hiding place of her 5 Guerilla sons.

C R E T E

DEPORTATIONS-EMILES :- In June 1943, the following were arrested and sent to prisons in Italy from Lassithion prefecture:- 1) George Markopoulos, he was later released. 2) G. Katapotis 3) Emmanuel Sifoyannis 4) Emm. Stylianakis 5) Y. Dedemetakis 6) Mikhail Darssedis 7) Heroulidis 8) A. Sophoulakis 9) Mikhail Roditis 10) Y. Mintreledakis.

All the above after Italy's collapse were handed over to the Germans and were sent to prisons in Germany.

A E G E A N I S L A N D S

MURDERS :- In January 1942, the Italians arrested 3 peasants of Hrisostomos village (Ikaria) because they were unable to deliver the large quantity of olive oil required by them. They were sent to Aghio Kyrikos prisons where they were tortured so much that a few days after their release, Ilias Moulas and Ioannis Skoudis died.

In September 1943, an Italian detachment moved towards Plomari village (Ikaria) to seize livestock. At their arrival, many innocent peasants were ill-treated. Amongst them old Tsantes was killed and many were wounded.

ARRESTS :- During 1942, Alex Parianos and Margaritis were arrested and tortured in Samos for unknown reason.

Also, the tanner Ipocratis Esoukaladakis had the same fate for hiding skins.

In 1943, Ioannis Tsampis, Sarandos Yemilas and Petros Fandaoutsos were arrested in Hrisostomos village (Ikaria) for helping the escapes to M.E. They were later released owing to amnesty.

During the same period, Chemist Yoannis Adamos was arrested and imprisoned in Aghios Kirikos for insulting the occupation authorities.

During January 1944, the remaining Italians in Ikaria, continued their arrests, violations and plunders. Thus, Constantinos Papayannis, Emmanuel Betsakos, Ilias Pardos and another two of unknown identity, were arrested for possessing arms, but nothing was found. They are detained in the Aghios Kerikos prisons, threatened to be executed in case arms are found in possession of the inhabitants of the island.

DEPORTATIONS-EMILES :- During the Italian occupation in Greece, the following were arrested and sent to Spoleto prisons in Italy :-

- 2) Nic. Hadzizoglou, for possessing arms.
- 3) Dimitrios Zellas, for possessing arms.

- 7) Thomas Kitsos, for possessing arms.

- 8) Const. Sirmiotis, for anti-axis propaganda

- 10) George Kapsalis, for helping Britishers, (he died in prison)
- 11) Dim. Konstas, for sabotage.

All the above were handed over to the Germans after Italy's collapse and were sent to concentration camps or prisons in Germany.
