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POLISH ACTIVITIES IN THE UNITED STATES

Beginning on June 3, 1976, a pamphlet in the Polish language, titled, "Walka Trwa" (the struggle continues), appeared in the Polish community in Chicago. It was mailed to various leaders of the Polish community, and appeared at certain Polish fraternal organizations. The author or distributor are currently unknown.

Several sources and complainants have made copies of it available to the Chicago Division claiming that it is extremely inflammatory in nature.

A translation of the pamphlet, prepared by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Laboratory, Washington, D.C., is as follows:

The Struggle Continues

Win.

The situation existing in the United States today is reminding us of the final years of the Polish Republic in the 17th century. Demoralization of the ruling class, feeling of security in disarmament, justification for moral cowardice, concessions to the enemy and finally hysteria of animal hatred for centers telling the truth are common to the two declining powers: Poland in the 17th century and the United States in the 20th century. We the Polish Section of a world organization, ATER-FO (Alliance To End Red-Fascist Oppression), understand perfectly well the causes of Poland's disintegration and consequently, together with our brothers, will have to stop the red fascist epidemic first in Polonia life and then together with other nationality sections in the United States and throughout the world.

A clandestine and sabotage activity is the only means to completely render harmless all undertakings by the red fascists and their sympathizers in the United States. All actions taken against the mental pygmies with red-fascist leanings are completely justifiable. These people are either outright red fascists or opportunists or simply fools. History teaches that these people should be annihilated because they are against the democratic progress of mankind. By annihilating red fascists we are making our contribution to democratic society and are cementing international friendship of free people.

Terror as Necessity

All manner of Warsaw degenerates are operating more and more boldly in Polonia. Enough! They have been committing excesses with impunity for too long.

Our slogan is TERROR and SABOTAGE directed against Warsaw agents. Our enemy is everyone who cooperates with the Warsaw regime openly, half-openly or secretly; everyone who disseminates pro-Warsaw propaganda; everyone who attends events organized by the Polish consulate; everyone who engages in divisive activity in Polonia; everyone who supports the communist reality; everyone who accepts the present-day enslavement of Poland for gain or peace of mind; everyone who hobnobs with the Warsaw regime; everyone who is suspected of communist sympathies.

We are recommending two types of terror. Both of them have been tried out by communists and have been found by them to be the best. Therefore, we will now turn their own old methods against them. One of them is the INDIRECT TERROR directed against private property; the other is the DIRECT TERROR aimed at individual. In the case of Warsaw agents each method is good as long as it is effective.

The indirect terror can be used against homes or motor vehicles of Warsaw agents. It may be smashing window-panes with rocks; splashing homes or cars with red paint; painting hammer and sickle on homes; making telephone calls at night; mailing anonymous letters and leaflets; spreading all sorts of rumors.

The direct terror means inflicting physical harm by beatings and liquidations.

History demands the settling of scores for Katyn, for Poznan, for Gdansk and for other killings. The hour of struggle has arrived.

### Ideological Principles of the Terrorist

Any person can be a terrorist, but to be a good terrorist that person has to be a man of character. The first principle is belief in his convictions; the second is belief in the righteousness of his cause. He who believes he is doing the right thing will put his heart into it. He has to dedicate himself with all his heart and soul to the terrorist struggle against the Warsaw regime. He who has patriotism at heart will easily understand the need for it.

No terrorist act should be carried out without advance planning. Every detail has to be known. But first a decision has to be made against whom the action will be taken and what will be done.

We find out the home address and the telephone number of the Warsaw agent or sympathizer. We identify the automobile he drives and the license plate number. We learn his habits and reconnoiter the area of action. Then we proceed to act.

It is advisable for the beginners to carry out first minor assignments. They may start out, for example, with threatening telephone calls, anonymous letters and fliers in order to engage later on in major operations such as splashing cars and homes of Warsaw agents with red paint, smashing window-panes, arson. Such actions as beatings or killings of individuals call for experience and courage. They are recommended for cold-blooded and experienced people.

Absolute prudence should be exercised during any kind of operation against Warsaw agents. Not even one's family should be trusted, because someday or somehow somebody may accidentally let the cat out of the bag. Warsaw's intelligence service is not asleep; there are plenty of agents provocateurs. Only persons carrying out the assignment need to know about the mission. No one else!

#### Practical Suggestions Concerning Clandestine and Sabotage Activity

Do not take active part in the official life of an organization. It is very easy to identify you if you do.

If you decide on carrying out an action, work out your plan of action to the smallest detail and go over it twice.

Never throw objects from a moving motor vehicle. Your license plate number may be spotted.

One of the best ways is harassing red fascists with telephone calls at night. Never give warning of the coming action; do not scare them or make threats. Only after carrying out the action anonymously inform them of the reasons for it.

Get to know everything about your enemy; his habits and environment. Never forget to exercise caution.

Never take your enemy lightly, but also do not hesitate to carry out your sabotage act.

In addition to your enemies, try to get to know your allies -- people you can count on.

Never go for the capital punishment if you are not certain of your determination. Remember that material losses can hurt badly. Try not to destroy objects that are insured. But, if you have to, do it several times in a row.

### Blacklist

We are publishing a blacklist below in order to make the work easier for future saboteurs. We divide our enemies into two groups: open agents of the Warsaw regime and sympathizers of the Warsaw regime. The first group deserves the capital punishment.

The open agents of the Warsaw regime are: the Rev. Michal Pawelek, Edward Puacz, Robert Lewandowski, Jerzy Przymuski, George Migala, Jozef Migala, John Kalin, Stanislaw Smolenski, and Adam Grzegorzewski.

The sympathizers of the Warsaw regime are: Dr. Rytel, Jozef Sikora, Maria Lorys, Wanda Kalin, Michal Przemyski, Jozef Bialasewicz, and Marian Czarniecki.

### Practical Advice

The arsenal of a conspirator and saboteur need not be complex. Homemade devices are very effective, versatile and irksome weapons. We use eggs for this purpose.

We take an egg, puncture small holes at both ends and suck out the egg's contents (yolk and the white). We then seal one opening with a strip of adhesive tape and fill the empty eggshell with (1) gasoline, (2) red paint, (3) acid (for example, from a car battery), or (4) other incendiary agents through the other opening. After sealing the opening, the egg/device is ready to be used.

If the egg is to be filled with gasoline, the holes are to be sealed first with thin rubber patches (for example, patches for bicycle tube). We do everything with rubber gloves on.

To ignite a target from a distance, it is best to use the so-called "magic candles." They do not go out when thrown, and they can be easily attached to the egg with a plastic adhesive tape. Eggs filled with gasoline are very suitable weapons against stores, motor vehicles, offices, consulates, homes, etc.

Gasoline is one of the most popular and accessible incendiary agents. When combined with other agents, it becomes a powerful weapon in the arsenal of a high-principled terrorist.

Napalm gasoline -- By adding laundry soap (powder) to gasoline we obtain a jellied mixture which sticks very well to the surface and burns for a long time. It is almost impossible to extinguish it.

Alcoholic gasoline -- We mix alcohol with gasoline, then add soap flakes and keep on stirring until the mixture thickens. Such a mixture burns very intensely. When used in an egg, it is very effective.
