<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 1922 - Graduated Military Academy. 2. 1930 - Graduated from War College, and in 1934 was sent to France to study; he was an observer in Ethiopia during Italian invasion. 3. After return to Japan in 1936, he was assigned to Mobilisation and Organization Section of JIGS. 4. 1939 - operations officer with Kwantung Army Hqs, participated in Nomonhan Incident. 5. - For a time was instructor in Infantry School. 6. 1940 - For several months, was member Army Education Section, then moved to Operations Section, but he resigned when his immediate superior, Lt. Col. TANAKA Shinichi, resigned because of difference opinion with War Minister TOJO over Guadalcanal operations. 7. Dec 42 - Jul 44 - Secretary for TOJO, under whom he had worked in 32-33 when latter was chief of JIGS Mobilisation and Organization Section. 8. Jul 44 - Recalled to JIGS at request of chief, Gen UMEZU, as chief of operations. 9. - Head of HATTORI Kikan 10. - Head, Historical Data Research Institute (Shijitsu Kenkyu Sho), which used various former Army officers to conduct historical and other types of research on military matters and from time to time published books and pamphlets.
