1. Former Lt. General HAMADA Tadashi invited MATSUBI Kiyoshi, Lt. General IMAKURO Hideo, and MATSUBI Oryand, Col. MATSUBI Kiyoshi, to dinner recently in order to bring about a rapprochement between MATSUBI and IMAKURO. The invitation issued to HAMADA in itself was an interesting prediction of the type of evening it was to become, since HAMADA obviously was giving credence to the current rumor in the public that HAMADA is part of MATSUBI's political action group. Although HAMADA and MATSUBI are merely friends, and are in no way connected politically or militarily, and although HAMADA is not a member of MATSUBI's reirement group, nevertheless such was the apparent supposition.
2. At the dinner, Lt. General HAMADA urged each of the participants to disclose what he had in his mind to the other one so that all misunderstandings might be eliminated between "the two great military leaders, MATSUBI and IMAKURO".
3. IMAKURO took up the challenge quite gracefully. He said to MATSUBI, "You may be informed at the present time by general rumor that I have been saying bad things against you." To this remark, MATSUBI replied that such was true. He added that in the past he had little interest in such news but that since the rumor was getting more and more rampant at present he could not ignore it. IMAKURO then stated that there was absolutely no foundation in fact for the rumors that he had been maligning MATSUBI. MATSUBI stated that since the time in the fall of 1950 when it had been apparent that there was no possibility for him to enter the National Police Reserve, he had no direct concern in the reirement issues and did not have one at present. IMAKURO then said that he had never been primarily concerned himself with the reirement issues at all but was merely interested in the political, intelligence, and economic fields and desirous of working within those areas. Such being the case, it was obviously impossible that he should malign any efforts which MATSUBI might have made on the reirement issues or in connection with the Police Reserve. In this manner, IMAKURO completely denied the rumor.
4. Since the report that IMAKURO had been spreading malicious rumors concerning MATSUBI had been reported to the latter in detail by a person in very close touch with IMAKURO, it was very difficult to believe that the report was entirely baseless despite IMAKURO's denial. MATSUBI did not feel that the dinner had made any basic change in his relationship to IMAKURO, nor in

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**INTERVIEW WITH MRS. KUSS has been reported to have his own intelligence gathering organization, but there is no indication that he has actively entered the recruitment field. Actually, much of KUSS' recruitment, information and efforts are believed to go to agents of KUSS' brother. This also is merely a generally accepted rumor. Nothing more.
