[] [] who gets most of his information directly from HATTORI, has not confirmed HAYASHI's charge that a member of the HATTORI Organization has denounced HAYASHI to the Attorney-General's office for pro-Communist leanings, nor has [] [] ever mentioned rumors to the effect that HAYASHI had such leanings.
