- About 10 April 1952, GHQ unofficially informed former (Colonal HATTORI Takushiro that his position as head of the Historical Records Department, Mar Demohilisation Board, would be terminated when the Feace Treaty took effect and that he would be attached to the Demohilisation Board in an unspecified, but apparently unisportant, position? The unfavorable publicity he has been getting letaly in the press is the reason for HATTORI's dismissal. HAR Shiro (M. US R.), a HATTORI subordinate, was scheduled to replace HATTORI when the Historical Records Department was cut down to section size and HATTORI was removed. HATTORI stated on 7 April 1952 that he knew he would lose his position and that he intended to resign from his future job with the Demobilisation Board in August 1952.
- disapproved of such a move and eagerly sought from the three visitors any political information they might have.
